

## **IMPORTANT FAMILY CAMP INFORMATION:**

**REGISTRATION PROCESS:** Please complete, sign, and return the admission application to the Camp office along with the required deposit. The deposit is credited toward the camp fee if you are accepted. Applications are considered on a first come/first serve basis. A confirmation letter will be sent upon receipt of the application. Spaces are limited. In the event that Family Camp is full, you will be placed on a **waiting list** and advised of alternatives. As cancellations occur, applicants will be accepted off the waiting list in the order they were received. An information packet will be mailed to all registered participants prior to arrival in August. This packet will include directions, what-to-bring list, cabin assignment, etc.

**PAYMENT AND FEES:** Camp fees include all program areas, meals and lodging. *Full payment of the camp fee along with an accurate list of names and ages of participants is to be received **on or before June 30, 2020**.* Failure to meet payment schedule may forfeit application. Spending money for camp store souvenirs is additional. We do not offer pro-rated fees. A cabin minimum of \$3,020 per cabin is in place to reflect the true costs of delivering a quality Camp Manito-wish YMCA Family Camp program. In addition, through encouraging families to share cabins with others, we hope to serve more families who in the past may have been placed on a waiting list. In meeting the \$3,020 minimum, you may guarantee a cabin exclusive to your family group.

**CANCELLATION POLICY:** If your family cancels:

1. Before Feb.1 Camp Manito-wish will retain \$100 of deposit.
2. Between Feb. 1 and June 1, Camp Manito-wish will retain the full deposit.
3. In the event of cancellation on or after June 1, Camp Manito-wish will retain 100% of the session fee.

**COMMUNITY STANDARDS:** Camp Manito-wish YMCA is a non-profit organization dedicated to developing spirit, mind, and body. Camp is open to all without regard to race, color, national origin, sex, age, or handicap. This is an adventure where participants are encouraged to participate in the whole program. We will be working, living, and growing together as a community. In the Manito-wish community, we realize that all of our actions affect each other. Participants are expected to demonstrate the core values of caring, honesty, respect, and responsibility. Camp Manito-wish is a non-smoking facility. Application signifies acceptance of these standards.

**CLOTHING AND LINENS:** Northwoods weather is unpredictable. We strongly suggest that you come prepared for a wide range of temperatures. Some items to include: long pants (required for horseback riding) wool sweaters, warm jacket, swim suit, suntan lotion, rain gear, grubby clothes, flashlight, and shoes that can get wet and be used on the waterfront (required for boating and sailing). Linens are not provided by Camp. Please bring your own twin-sized sheets, blankets, pillows and towels.

**SPECIAL CONCERNS FOR YOUNG CHILDREN:** Children under ten should bring a life vest or swimming aid for waterfront use. Swimming takes place in Boulder Lake. Parents are responsible for supervising children on the waterfront. Other suggested items include a booster or high chair, and favorite games, toys or books. If bringing bicycles, helmets must be worn when on camp property. Youth sized bicycles will not be provided by Camp Manito-wish YMCA.

**MEDICAL REQUIREMENTS:** Camp Manito-wish YMCA is not responsible for any medical or surgical charges. Each person is responsible for his or her own medical care and coverage. If you need medical help, the Howard Young Medical Center is located in Woodruff, approximately 20 miles from Camp Manito-wish.

**DIRECTIONS:** Travel North on Highway 51 through Minocqua/Woodruff, Wisconsin. Turn right onto County Highway M. Travel approximately 10 miles into the town of Boulder Junction. Keep to the left and exit town on West County Highway K. Camp is one mile west of town on Highway K.
