



IMPORTANT WEEKEND INFORMATION

General Weekend Rules

- ❖ All minors must have a parent/guardian/authorized adult on Camp grounds at all times. All children under the age of 10 must be supervised by a parent/guardian/authorized adult at all times.
- ❖ Note that the Manito-wish staff is managing the safe operation of program activities and are not responsible for the whereabouts of your children as they travel around Camp.
- ❖ Wear shoes or sandals at all times while at Camp.
- ❖ No pets are allowed at Camp during the weekend celebration.
- ❖ Camp is smoke free, alcohol free and drug free.
- ❖ No lodging is available at Camp for the 100th Anniversary weekend — this includes camping.

Food and Drink

- ❖ Camp is offering breakfast, lunch and dinner on Saturday and Sunday. Please register for attendance at specific meals in advance of the weekend.
- ❖ Attendees who reported special dietary needs will be served their main lunch options at their seats in Nash, or if dining in the Trips Lawn tent vegetarian and gluten free options will be labeled on the buffet.
- ❖ Refreshments will be available throughout the day in designated areas.
- ❖ Please do not take food and drinks into the cabins.
- ❖ Please help Camp stay clean and looking beautiful by disposing of all food waste and trash appropriately.

Boulder Lake

- ❖ No swimming without a designated Manito-wish staff member on duty.
- ❖ Swimming is permitted in designated areas only at the waterfront.
- ❖ Wet shoes must be worn during all boating activities.
- ❖ Lifejackets must be worn for all boating activities.
- ❖ Always walk on the pier.
- ❖ Camp boats may be taken out only when Manito-wish staff is on duty.
- ❖ No Camp boats may be taken out after dark.

Camp Buildings and Program Areas

- ❖ Please be respectful of the weekend staff housing areas and do not enter the buildings marked 'Staff Housing'.
- ❖ No graffiti on any cabin, walls, buildings.
- ❖ Please do not use or touch the equipment at the Challenge Course unless it is open and staffed during Coaching Periods.
- ❖ Please do not enter Camp buildings marked 'Closed'.

Baby Changing/ Feeding Stations

- ❖ The Health Center is designated for baby changing and feeding.

Special Program Notes

- ❖ Basic first aid will be available in the open Program areas and Boyce Administration during the hours Camp is open for the event on Saturday and Sunday. AED's are located in Boyce Administration, Health Center and MLC Lobby.
- ❖ In the event of inclement weather Camp has designated storm shelters. Please look for a Camp staff member to direct you to an appropriate location. Camp staff will update you on when it is safe to resume activities.
