

# CAMP MANITO-WISH YMCA – OUTPOST TRIP LEADER

### MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

- 1. Minimum of 20 years old for Voyageur Level, 21 years old for other Tripping Levels
- 2. Previous leadership experience
- 3. Knowledge of camping equipment maintenance and care
- 4. Ability to work independently and meet deadlines
- 5. Certification in Wilderness Water Safety, CPR, and Wilderness First Responder
- 6. Desire and proven ability to work with children
- 7. Ability to teach and model optimism, resilience, humility, empathy, awareness of self and others, resourcefulness, responsibility and adaptability

### **RESPONSIBLE TO:** Outpost Assistant Director(s), Outpost Director, and Wilderness Program Director

### **ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:**

- 1. Ability to communicate and work effectively with groups of campers (age and skill levels), and provide necessary instruction to campers
- 2. Must be able to relate effectively to diverse groups of people
- 3. Ability to observe camper's behavior, assess its appropriateness, enforce safety regulations and emergency procedures, and apply appropriate behavior management techniques
- 4. Visual and auditory ability to identify and respond to environmental and other hazards related to the Outpost program and the trail
- 5. Physical ability to respond appropriately to situations requiring first aid, fire evacuation and illness
- 6. Possess strength and endurance required to maintain constant supervision of staff and campers
- 7. Cognitive and communication abilities to plan and conduct activities to achieve camper development

## **SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- 1. Maintain Manito-wish philosophies and high tripping standards
- 2. Provide opportunities for discussion centering on Camp's mission and personal growth
- 3. Assist in food pack-out and equipment related duties
- 4. Drive as needed (those that are at least 21)
- 5. Create a well-balanced and diverse menu and assemble all food items needed in the field
- 6. Become familiar with the use and applications of all items in the Outpost first aid kit
- 7. Assure that all participants have necessary personal clothing and equipment essential to their wilderness experience
- 8. Present information on various training topics to staff and participants both in-camp and in the field
- 9. Actively participate in all training sessions
- 10. Responsible for record keeping, retention of all receipts, safety, and accountability for all petty cash
- 11. Complete all pre and post trip paperwork including: introductory letter, trip logs, camper evaluations, expense logs, incidents and near miss reports, and final parent letters
- 12. Maintain and be accountable for all equipment issued from the gear room
- 13. Maintain the health, safety, and general welfare of trip participants
- 14. Complete a detailed itinerary including, routes, campsites, and evacuation plans before leaving camp
- 15. Maintain the cleanliness of program and living facilities
- 16. Understand and commit to the Manito-wish Mission, Vision and Commitment Statements
- 17. Understand and commit to the YMCA core values of caring, honesty, respect, and responsibility
- 18. Understand and commit to all policies related to Child Abuse Prevention directed by Camp Manito-wish YMCA
- 19. Provide opportunities for participant/staff discussion centering on Camp's mission and personal growth

- 20. Uphold rules and policies associated with Camp Manito-wish YMCA and support the group living experience
- 21. Capable of effective and sustained mental, emotional, and social interaction with others in the camp's fastpaced, youth-centered, community living environment
- 22. Able to maintain mental, emotional and social resiliency (such as handling stressful situations appropriately) needed for the job in a fast-paced, interactive environment
- 23. Perform other duties as assigned

#### **TIME OFF:**

- 1. One 24-hour period off per week
- 2. Any other time off at the discretion of the Outpost Director or the Wilderness Program Director
