

# **CAMP MANITO-WISH YMCA – CAMP DRIVER**

## **MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:**

- 1. Minimum of 21 years old
- 2. Standard First Aid and CPR (Certifications may be obtained through Camp Manito-wish prior to first day of work)
- 3. Have a valid driver's license
- 4. NO traffic violations within 12 months of starting date of employment
- 5. Good written and verbal communication skills
- 6. Strong and good character: optimism, resilience, humility, empathy, awareness of self and others, resourcefulness, responsibility and adaptability

## **ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS:**

- 1. Ability to communicate and work with groups participating (age and skill levels), and provide necessary instruction to campers and staff
- 2. Must be able to relate effectively to diverse groups of people
- 3. Able to complete Camp Manito-wish's driver training course and all its requirements
- 4. Adaptability to ensure all driving needs are covered
- 5. Follow the rules of the road and Camp driving procedures
- 6. Safely transport campers, staff to needed destination
- 7. Maintain clean vehicles and trailers
- 8. Ability to communicate and train staff and campers in safety regulations and emergency procedures
- 9. Ability to work independently, meet deadlines, and communicate effectively
- 10. Physical ability to respond appropriately to situations requiring first aid, fire evacuation and illness
- 11. Abilities to observe camper behavior, assess its appropriateness, enforce appropriate safety regulations and emergency procedures, and apply appropriate behavior-management techniques
- 12. Comfortable and interested in outdoor living and willing to develop expertise in boating
- 13. Effectively communicate, plan and conduct activities to achieve camper development
- 14. Visual and auditory ability to identify and respond to environmental and other hazards related to the in-camp program

#### **SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- 1. Serve as one of Camp's primary drivers
- 2. Teach and monitor proper use of seat-belts, safe loading and unloading, proper behavior on the vehicle, and other aspects of vehicle safety
- 3. Manage petty cash account; submit all receipts marked indicating purpose
- 4. Participate in special activities, evening activities, and opening/closing day events
- 5. Assist with creatively leading additional program areas when a driver is not needed
- 6. Be familiar with and follow procedures for reporting accidents, injuries, incidents, safety check, backing up, loading and unloading and vehicle break down
- 7. Be familiar with any health problems of campers and staff that are transported
- 8. Actively participate in all training sessions
- 9. Keep records on vehicle maintenance and mileage
- 10. Understand and commit to the Manito-wish Mission, Vision and Commitment Statements

- 11. Understand and commit to the YMCA core values of caring, honesty, respect, and responsibility
- 12. Understand and commit to all policies related to Child Abuse Prevention directed by Camp Manito-wish YMCA
- 13. Provide opportunities for camper/staff discussion centering on Camp's mission and personal growth
- 14. Uphold rules and policies associated with Camp Manito-wish YMCA and support the group living experience
- 15. Capable of effective and sustained mental, emotional, and social interaction with others in the camp's fastpaced, youth-centered, community living environment
- 16. Able to maintain mental, emotional and social resiliency (such as handling stressful situations appropriately) needed for the job in a fast-paced, interactive environment
- 17. Perform other duties as assigned
